

Monday is Trash Day!

Beech Mountain Lakes will have community-wide curbside trash service.

Please have your trash out at the curb by 6:00 AM or put it out the night before.

The Management and Board of Beech Mountain Lakes has selected a single waste company to provide all trash collection service for our community. By contracting as a community with one waste company, we can get the lowest price, reduce the number of trash trucks and better control waste service.

J. P. Mascaro & Sons will be the hauler, after receiving proposals from a number of qualified waste companies. They are a family owned, Pennsylvania based company known throughout our area for their quality service.

Billing is the responsibility of Beech Mountain Lakes Association. Invoices will be sent quarterly and are due by the 15th of the month. (Jan.-Apr.-July-Oct.) The rate will be \$49 per quarter.

Refuse service and fees are mandatory for all residences as an assessment by the Beech Mountain Lakes association and subject to all collection procedures.

Trash

Trash will be collected once a week on Mondays. Up to six cans or bags per household will be collected. No trash or recycling containers will be supplied. You may use your own containers. Cans or bags must not exceed 50 pounds or 35 gallons. Containers will be replaced on the curb.

No Hazardous Wastes!

Car batteries, gasoline, motor oil, pesticides, oil-base paints and other toxic and hazardous materials do not belong in the trash! Call Luzerne County's Solid Waste Management Department at 800-821-7654 or 570-820-6300 for information on disposing of these materials. Many auto stores accept used motor oil and car batteries.

Bulk Items

One bulk item, such as a piece of furniture or a major appliance may be set out on the first collection day of each month. Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners & dehumidifiers contain Freon (CFCs) that by law must be removed before they can be disposed of. You MUST have the Freon removed by a refrigeration mechanic and a certification sticker put on before putting the item out for collection. Most appliance dealers and repair shops can do this.

Please!

No home construction or demolition debris! If you're putting on a new roof or remodeling your house, you need to make special arrangements with J. P. Mascaro & Sons or another waste hauler to remove the debris. Call the number below for more information.
