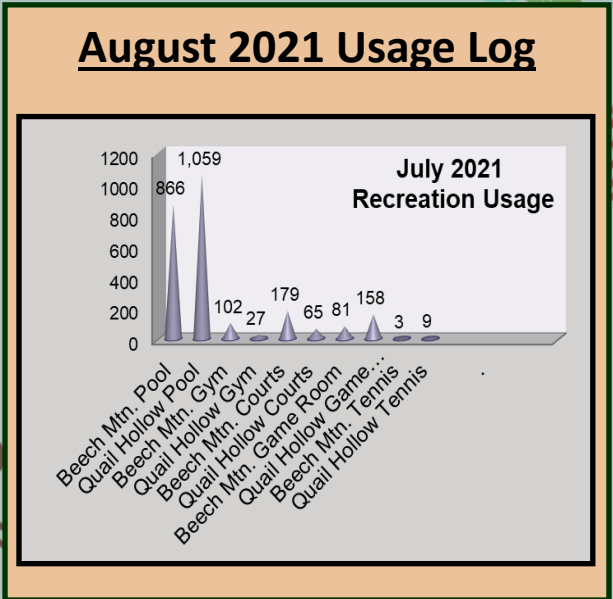

TIPS FROM PENN STATE MASTER GARDENERS

HELLO BEECH MOUNTAIN GARDENERS!

August is a wonderful time to enjoy the garden. Fast growing lawns tend to go dormant reducing the frequency of required mowing. Flowering annuals planted in May and June often reach their peak in August, and perennials likewise put on the best show this month.

CONTAIN YOUR GARDEN

Many Beech Mountain gardeners have discovered the value of growing plants in containers. Container plants

will reduce the weight of the finished product, and the quantity of soil needed to fill the container.

Regular watering of container grown plants is critical. If you enjoy week-long vacations, make sure to have a friend or neighbor check on your containers.

Choose plants that will complement the container. Make sure the light requirements of the plants match the location where you intend to place the container. I have some spots on my deck that will allow a few sun loving plants, but most locations are more suited to shade loving plants.

This year I am taking advantage of tropical foliage plants that include rex begonias, coral bells and caladiums. Coleus are available in a wide variety of colors and leaf shapes.



avoid the problem of poor rocky soils common in our area. They can be located on decks out of the reach of deer. And placed to gain the most sun exposure. Containers offer the advantage of being portable. As the seasons, temperature and light conditions change, you can move your containers to maintain the desired conditions for peak performance.

Plants can be grown in just about any container as long as it has adequate drainage holes to prevent water logging. Containers can be large or small formal or whimsical, colorful or neutral.

You will have the greatest success using a quality commercial potting soil. Good soil will be free of diseases and weeds that might be found in garden soil. If you are planting in large containers (deeper than 12 –15 inches you can add Styrofoam blocks, packing peanuts or empty capped soda bottles to the bottom of the container. This

Traditional impatiens can provide colorful flowers, and some varieties of New Guinea impatiens called sun-patiens add tolerance to sun. Cannas make dramatic container plants. While they flower later in the summer, there are varieties with colorful foliage that will brighten your deck or patio all summer.

Containers can be multi season gardens as tropicals and annuals fade in the fall they can be replaced by chrysanthemums. Flowering kale can last into early winter and is available in many forms and colors.
