The BML Sports Club Kids' Fishing Derby is scheduled to take place on Saturday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2014 from 9:30am to 11:30am at the spillway in Quail Hollow. Sign-in will begin at 8:00am. The registration price is \$2.00 per child, ages 4 to 14. You can register your child at the Rec Center during business hours or the morning of the Derby. The Sports Club will be netting an area off and stocking over 800 trout that range in sizes from 9", 14" and trophy fish up to 24". 100 of the trout will be tagged. The highest numbered tagged fish caught by a boy and a girl will be the winners of new bicycles. The largest measured fish caught, boy and girl, will win new fishing rods. The first five fish caught by a boy or a girl, will receive a prize. As always, the Sports Club will provide each participant with a gift. This year, the club has decided to give the children Beech Mountain Lakes Sports Club water bottles at registration before the Derby. A hotdog and soda will be given to each paid participant and will be for sale at low cost to anyone in attendance.

#### **2014 Rules and Regulations:**

- 1.) No crossing the spillway. All fishing will take place on the Quail Hollow banks.
- 2.) Single Hook Fishing only. No treble hooks or spinners will be allowed.
- 3.) The BML Sports Club is encouraging parents/guardians to teach and assist the children when casting, but letting them do as much on their own especially while reeling in the fish.

The cost of the Derby has increased this year. In order to help offset some of the costs, we are asking any local businesses if they would like to be a sponsor. This can be done in monetary form or by donating needed items such as paper products, sodas and waters, hotdogs & buns, and small snacks. All sponsors will be properly thanked the day of the Derby by posting the business name on a sponsor board. In addition, a big thank you will be posted on Voices and in June's newsletter. Also, any sponsor can feel free to bring a promotional item to display and have a representative attend the Derby. In past years, the Derby has had upwards of 500 people in attendance.
